Petit posy is whizzing out – the super veg cross of sprouts and kale. Sacks of spuds are a pre Christmas must have! We haven't got the greatest stock, but should have enough till just after Christmas! Other veg includes: beetroot, cabbages and squash. The squash have been really popular this year with many more people trying this incredibly easy and yummy veg. Onion squash, butternut, harlequin and gemstone – all brilliant roasted in the oven! We still have a very few raspberries for PYO and we have a great supply of all our own berries in the freezer.
